

Loofah, Washrag and Soap Saver



For this project you will need 5mm or a US size H hook and some cotton / pac yarn (8ply)

ch = chain
dc = double crochet
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)

Round one

ch 5, sl st in beginning ch to form a ring.

Round two

ch 50 the sl st into ring to make the loop handle for the loofah, then dc 30 into center ring, sl st into beginning dc.

Round three and four

ch 2 then dc 3 into same space, dc 4 into next space, repeat dc 4 in all sts. Sl st into beginning dc. Sl st into beginning dc. After round four ch 1 and cut yarn, hide

tail.



For this project you will need a 5mm hook or a size H US hook and cotton / pac (8 ply) yarn. Or any soft yarn that would make a soft wash cloth. This wash cloth

is done by using the mesh stitch.

Ch = chain

sc = single crochet

sp = space

st(s) = stitch(es)

sl st = slip stitch

sk a st = skip a stitch

Round one

Ch 30, then sc into 2nd ch from hook and ch 1, sk a st and sc into 4th st. repeat pattern (SC, CH 1, sk a st, SC) ch 1 and turn.

Round two

sc into the ch space from the previous round, ch 1, continue pattern (sc, ch1, sk a st, sc) the last stitch of the row is done in the ch 1 from the previous row, sc into the space. (When you ch 1 and turn to do another round) then ch 1 and turn.



Rounds three – thirty

Repeat rows 1 and 2

When you get to the last stitch on the 30th row, you want to start crab stitching in every other st. Make sure your loop on your hook is not too tight, so that the stitches don't pull together so much. Do this all the way around. When you get to your last crab st, ch 10 and sl st into the beginning crab st of the round, (to make the loop) ch 1 cut yarn. Work in tail.



For this project you will need a 6mm hook or a US size J and medium worst weight (10ply) yarn. Some yellow and a bit of white. And a stitch marker of some kind. Also you will need a size 4mm hook or a US size 6 hook to make the chain handle.

Ch = Chain
sc = single crochet
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)
dec = decrease

Round one

Ch 15 then sc in 2nd chain from hook. Sc in all sts (14) then continue to sc in opposite side of stitches (14 sts), sl st into beginning sc. PLACE MARKER HERE

Round two – eight

Sc in all sts around. Always sl stitching into beginning sc

Round nine

Sc 4 then do 1 dec, continue for whole round (23 sts)

Round ten

Sc 4 then do 1 dec, continue for whole round (19 sts)

Rounds eleven and twelve

Sc in all sts around (19 sts)

Round 13

ch 2, dc 4, popcorn using top of ch 2, ch 1 and skip a stitch, Do 5 dc's on next st and popcorn. Continue all around for a total of 10 popcorns.

Round 14

ch 3, dc in all the tops of the popcorn (the space left in between the dc's) and dc in all the ch 1 spaces (19 sts) ch 1 cut yarn, weave in tails.

Making the draw string

Ch 90 and sl st into beginning ch to form a loop, ch 1 cut yarn, work in ends. Now weave the double ch through the spaces between the dc's.

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
